Deed Restrictions / Violations

For all deed restriction violations recorded in 2006, a letter is sent to the homeowner regarding the violation, with a request for correction. 99% of the reported violations are promptly corrected. The board would like to thank every resident for their cooperation and great support. As a reminder, the board would like to ask each resident to please continue helping to keep our neighborhood looking great. Sever**a** items to stay focused on are:

- ? General Lawn Care- mowing/edging
- ? Improperly parked vehicles
- ? Repair / Replace loose or broken fence boards
- '? Fence Height 6' 6"
- ? Hanging / Falling Gutters
- ? Materials are to be stored out of sight from street
- ? Pets being allowed to roam the neighborhood
- ? Trash Can left on curbside after collection

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Deed Restriction Reminders

The Board of Directors continues to work on the issue of trash collection. To keep our neighborhood in top shape, changes were made to the deed restrictions to include the following guidelines:

- Trash containers and recycling bins are to be stored out of view from the front of the house.
- .9 Trash should not be placed at the curbside more than 24 hours before normal collection.
- .9 Trash containers and recycle bins should be picked up from the curb as soon as possible after collection.
- ·? Trash containers and recycle bins should not be placed in the street.

All residents are asked to follow these new guidelines.

Pest Control

Annual spraving of the MCCIA area has been ongoing for the last several years. In 2006, the board again increased the normal weekly spraving of the area to twiceweekly due to the risk of illness. The board has renewed the contract for 2007 for wekly spraying between April and November.
