Spring Is Here - Time To Take Care Of Our Lawns

Regular lawn care including mowing and edging is needed to keep our community in top condition. All homeowners and/or renters are required by our Deed Restrictions to take care of their yards. As a reminder failure to do so can lead to a deed restriction violation and the association hiring a contractor to correct the violation. Trash Can and Recycling Bins

Trash Cans and Recycling Bins are to be stored out of site from the street. These should be stored in your garage and/or behind your fence. Trash Cans and Recycling Bins are not to be placed out on the curb more than 24 hours prior to our scheduled pickup of Mondays and Thursdays. Tree trimmings, limbs and branchs must be cut and bundled into small bundles no longer than 4 feet, and should not weigh over 50 lbs.
