Deed Restrictions / Violations

For all deed restriction violations recorded in 209, a letter is sent to the homeowner regarding the violation, with a request for correction. 99% of the reported violations are promptly corrected. The board would like to thank every resident for their cooperation and great support. As a reminder, the board would like to ask each resident to please to keep our neighborhood looking great. Several items to stay focused on are:

- ? General Lawn Care- mowing/edging
- ? Improperly parked vehides
- ? Repair / Replace loose or broken fence boards
- ? Fence Height 6' 6"
- '? Hanging / Falling Gutters
- ? Materials are to be stored out of sight from street
- ? Pets being allowed to roam the neighborhood
- ? Trash Cans left on curbside after collection

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Trash Collection Guidelines

Trash collection is provided by the WaterDistrict - To keep our neighborhood in top shape, changes were made to the deed restrictions to include the following guidelines:

- ? Trash containers and recycling bins are to be stored out of view from the front of the house.
- ? Trash should not be placed at the curbside more than 24 hours before normal collection.
- ? Trash containers and recycle bins should be picked up from the curb as soon as possible after collection.
- ? Trash containers and recycle bins should not be placed in the street.

2010 Financial Overview

In October of 2009, annual assessment bills were mailed. A payment plan was available, which allowed assessments be paid in three payments. As of 12/31/09, \$27,852 of the 2010 assessments had been paid. Accounts are delinquent if not paid in full by 01/31/200 and a \$25.00 late fee and interest will be applied. Delinquent accounts will be turned over to our attorney for collection.

Security Patrol Projected 2010 Cost Increase

The Harris County Attorney, Mike Stafford issued a letter to notify the parties participating in the law enforcement services patrol program that there may be a substantial cost increase in theost beginning with renewals for the 2010 calendar year. The board of directors looked at what options we might have regarding any possible price increase. The 2010 contract cost increase was set and the board approved the renewal of the contract without any increase to residents. Future cost increase could lead to the addition of an annual security fee. 2009 cost per resident was\$ 63.44 and the 2010 cost per MCCIA resident isset at \$ 67.95.

2010 Outlook

The financial health of our association is good. The board is always looking ahead to the future to insure that we keep our present health. We continue to work to ensure that the best interests of our neighborhood are kept as the top priority. As always the board is open to the opinions of each resident.
